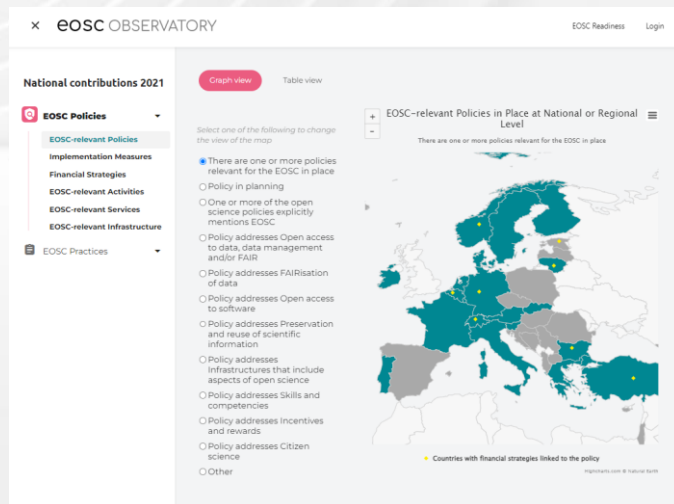
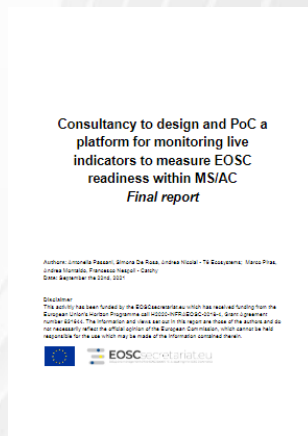


EOSC Readiness Dashboard PoC

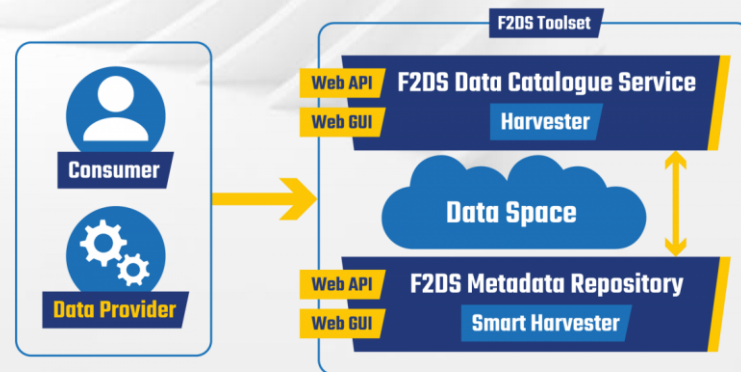
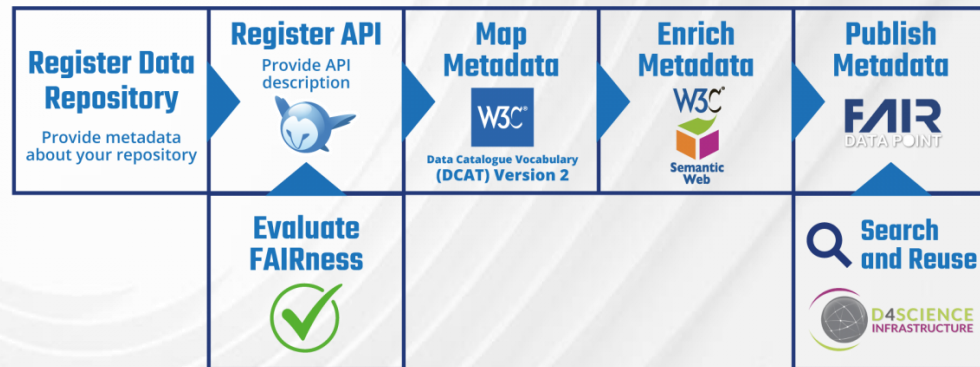
Federated FAIR Data Space
